What to Expect When Applying to Preschool or Kindergarten

Kindergarten and Preschool Interviews are scheduled at the end of February, with interviews taking place in March.

Preschool applicants will take part in a parent and teacher interview in which both parents attend without the child.

Kindergarten applicants are scheduled in small groups of 3-4 families in which both parents and the kindergarten child attend.

Bright Water School interviews all applicants and then announces acceptance status via mail.

Acceptance: Preschool and Kindergarten acceptance is based on such factors as the child's age, physical and social readiness, and the parents' willingness to work with the principles of Waldorf education.

What to Expect When Applying for Grade One

- Parent and Teacher Interview**
You will be scheduled for an interview between both parents of the applicant and two Bright Water Faculty Members shortly after we receive the above items.
- Child Assessment**
Your child will be assessed by two Bright Water Faculty Members.

Acceptance: **First grade applicants** must have turned 6 years old by May 31st during the year preceding first grade entry. Acceptance will be based on the teachers' assessment of developmental readiness as well as the parents' willingness to work with the principles of Waldorf education.
